

**Position Title: Lead Mural Artist**

Position Type: Part-time Temporary Contract

Contract Duration: July 1 - September 30, 2018, with possibility for extension

Pay: \$2,250 for entire duration, pro-rated as necessary

Resident Arts seeks a part-time (weekly hours will vary) Lead Mural Artist to work directly with the organization's director to execute the creation of a large-scale mural through a proven community mural making process. The Lead Artist will be in charge of a team of 4 assistants, including an Assistant Artist, and three Artist Trainees (16-20 years/old). The team will begin work on the design portion of the process in early July, and begin painting Mid-August. The mural must be completed by September 30th.

**Responsibilities:**

- Coordinate with director to ensure timely execution of each step of mural making process
- Manage team of 4 mural assistants to complete the mural within the defined schedule
- Work collaboratively with partner agencies to create a design for the mural
- Attend all public events as a representative of Resident Arts and its partners
- Ensure that required branding and copy is included on mural, and supplementary materials for public events
- Ensure exceptional engagement and efficiency from team of assistants
- Ensure the use of proper safety precautions, particularly with minors, at mural site
- Oversee and participate in design transfer and mural painting through to completion

**Qualifications:**

- \*\*\*Ability and willingness to do physical labor outside for many hours at a time\*\*\*
- BFA or equivalent experience
- History of teaching and/or project management experience in an art specific capacity
- Exceptional verbal and written communication skills
- Exceptional portfolio of 2D artworks - preferably demonstrating a bold and graphic style
- Ability to follow instructions and take direction on artistic output
